

## NAME

cpath -- Copies current working directory path to the MacOS clipboard

## SYNOPSIS

cpath [-vh]

## DESCRIPTION

cpath will copy the path returned by the `getcwd()` function into the MacOS clipboard. It is more convenient than:

```
# pwd | pbcopy
```

because it doesn't copy any newline character, which means you can paste the copied path into a terminal application without trying to execute it.

-h Prints help/usage.
