

NAME

geticon -- Get the icon of a Mac OS X file.

SYNOPSIS

geticon [-vh] [-t type] [-o outputfile] file

DESCRIPTION

geticon is a command line utility for extracting the icon from a Mac OS X file or folder. The default behaviour is to extract the icon to the current working directory in .icns format. This can be overridden using the -t and -o options described below.

A list of flags and their descriptions:

- o Allows you to designate a path where the icon file will be created
- t Allows you to specify what format you want to extract the icon to. Valid values are icns, png, gif, tiff and jpeg.
- v Prints version and author
- h Prints short help/usage string
