

NAME

google -- start Google search from the command line in MacOS X.

SYNOPSIS

google [-i] searchword ...

DESCRIPTION

google is a very small and simple program that enables you to open a browser window with a google query from the command line. You can pass the search words as multiple arguments or as a single argument within brackets.

An example of typical usage would be:

```
# google The Stuff That I need to look up
```

or, alternatively

```
# google 'The Stuff That I need to look up'
```

google supports the following options:

-i Search for images
