

## NAME

trash -- Moves files to the Trash

## SYNOPSIS

trash [file] ...

## DESCRIPTION

trash is akin to the 'rm' command but instead of unlinking files it moves them into the MacOS Trash in the user's home directory. It behaves in a similar way to the Finder in this respect, since files are renamed to 'File copy 1' and so forth if they already exist in the Trash.
